

# Financial Aid

## UW-Platteville offers three forms of Financial Aid:

- Grants: Money that a student does not pay back
  - Federal Pell Grant
  - Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant
  - Federal Indian Grant
  - Wisconsin Higher Education Grant
  - Talent Incentive Program
  - Wisconsin Indian Grant
  - Wisconsin Handicapped Grant
  - Lawton Undergraduate Retention Grant
  
- Loans:
  - Subsidized Federal Stafford Loan- Interest free for students enrolled at least half time.
  - Perkins Loans- Interest free for students enrolled at least half time.
  - Unsubsidized Federal Stafford Loan- Student will be responsible for the interest on the loan, while in school.
  - Federal Plus Loan- Available for parents of dependent undergraduate students.
  
- Student Employment: Working on Campus to help pay your tuition bill.
  - Federal work-study program
  - Regular student employment
  - Off campus jobs

## Financial Aid Eligibility at UW-Platteville:

- Complete the Free Application for Financial Student Aid (FAFSA) and mail into the processing Center, or apply on-line at: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
- UW-Platteville's Title IV code is: 003921
- UW-Platteville's Priority Date is: March 15th, remember that this is NOT a Deadline.

## Freshmen Scholarships

- Any Student who has applied and been accepted to UW-Platteville by November 15th will receive a scholarship brochure and will then become eligible to apply for the scholarships that UWP offers.
- Return all scholarship applications to the Financial Aid Office, by February 2nd. Applications received after this date, will not be considered for the freshman scholarships.
- Scholarship committees on campus will select recipients and students will be notified by May 1.
