Requirements

For **most** programs, a student must:

- have completed at least one full-time semester of college at the time of application.
- have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 grading scale.
- be in good academic standing at the time of participation.
- * Prior knowledge of a foreign language is not required.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

In most cases, a student's financial aid applies to study abroad programs. In addition, some special study abroad grants and scholarships are available.
