Series Notes: Millikin is making its first-ever trip to UW-Platteville. The Big Blue captured the inaugural meeting in Decatur, Ill., 65-58, last November ... the Pioneers are 4-4 vs. Illinois schools in Coach Tina Kuhle's four seasons ... Wednesday's game begins a six-game homestand for the Pioneers, their longest since the 2004-05 season ... UWP opens Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference play Saturday vs. UW-Superior at 1 p.m. The Pioneers are 5-1 against UWS under Coach Kuhle ... UWP has won the last 12 meetings at home against the Yellowjackets.

Bo Ryan Court: Bo Ryan Court was dedicated on Jan. 27, 2007 and named after the former Pioneer men's coach and current Wisconsin Badger coach who led the Pioneers to national championships in 1991, 1995, 1998 and 1999. The court is located in Williams Fieldhouse, built in 1962 and named after 42-year (1897-1939) mathematics professor William H. Williams, who also served as the chairman of the Athletic Committee and Boards for 35 years.

Pioneer Preview

UW-Platteville is making its home debut after starting 2-3. The Pioneers split games in both the Wheaton and Cardinal Stritch tournaments and lost at Coe, 76-67.

With no seniors on the roster, Coach Tina Kuhle is relying on her juniors for leadership. Lisa Wubben earned all-tournament honors in both gatherings. She is averaging 16 ppg, second in the WIAC. Lisa Grantman leads the league in steals at 3.2 per game and is averaging 11.8 ppg. Conny Droeszler rolled sevens in points and rebounds vs. Davenport, MI Saturday.

Sophomore Druscilla Schneider is averaging 7.6 rebounds per game and ranks second in the WIAC in offensive boards.

UWP set a new defensive record Sunday, holding Temple Baptist to 20 points in the 68-20 victory.

*The Pioneers set a new defensive record (in the shot-clock era) by holding Temple Baptist (Ohio) to 20 points in a 68-20 win Nov. 25. UWP led 39-4 at the half. The previous record was 28 points against Alverno College in a 84-28 win on Dec. 28, 2002.

11 **ASHLEY WOLF** is recovering from an ACL injury suffered high school and has come in off the bench as point guard in all five games ... she had career highs of 6 points, 3 rebounds, and 3 assists vs. Coe College.

12 **CHELSEY DROEZLER** did not play in the first four games but came in off the bench vs. Temple Baptist to have a career high of 8 points ... she is also recovering from an ACL injury.

14 **LISA GRANTMAN** is a co-captain... has started in 51 of 55 games played ... she has a career high of 24 points vs. Wheaton this season.

32 **VANESSA NEMITZ** returned from an ACL injury suffered late last season ... made first five starts of her collegiate carer ... scored career-best 16 points against UW-Superior last year.

33 **DRUSCILLA SCHNEIDER** went from playing in only 11 games last year to being the starting center ... has career highs of 11 points vs. Aurora, 11 rebounds vs. Davenport.

34 **BRIANNA KLAAS** is suffering from a season-ending injury ... scored career-best 25 at Augustana last year.

35 **LINDSAY AALUND** played in three of the five games ... career high vs. Wheaton with 3 rebounds.

40 **ASHLEY CALLAHAN** has played in all five games ... career high of 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. Temple Baptist.
