UW-Platteville vs. UW-Stevens Point

The Game:

UW-Platteville entertains UW-Stevens Point in the Pioneers' annual Homecoming game Saturday at 2 p.m. in Ralph E Davis Pioneer Stadium.

The Pioneers, despite out-gaining their opponents, are 1-3 overall and 0-1 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Pointers, who have the nation's second-longest winning streak at eight games, are 4-0 overall and 1-0 in the WIAC. UWSP has won the last 16 meetings, dating back to 1992 (the teams met twice in 2001).

All Pioneer games can be heard once again on WPVL 107.1 FM, with Doug Wagen and Mark Evanstad broadcasting from the booth and Bob Middendorf reporting from the sidelines.

The Coaches:

UW-Platteville Coach Mike Emendorfer is in his ninth season and has guided the Pioneers to two seasons of .500 or better in the last three years. Also in charge of the offense, Emendorfer led the second-most potent unit in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference last year, as the Pioneers averaged 374.8 yards per game. UWP has ranked in the top 30 in NCAA III passing yards in six of the last seven years.

UW-Stevens Point's John Meich has a 128-66-2 record in his 20th season. Meich is ranked fourth on the all-time WIAC wins list and is the conference's winningest active coach. He has posted 500 or better seasons in 17 of his 19 seasons.

The Pioneers:

UW-Platteville played three straight ranked non-conference opponents, beating NAIA #9 St. Ambrose 16-6, losing 20-7 to top-ranked (Football Championship Subdivision Mid-Major poll) Drake, and falling 34-24 to 29th-ranked (D3football.com) Augustana, Ill.

The Pioneers opened WIAC play with a 28-7 loss at UW-Stout, despite out-gaining the Blue Devils 345-234 and getting 23 first downs to Stout's 12. The hosts returned two interceptions and a punt for touchdowns.

The Pioneers are averaging 364 yards of offense per game, with 128 per game on the ground and 236 through

the air. Mike Genslinger has rushed for 467 yards and three TDs, while Michael Schmidt has thrown for 944 yards and four scores. Nick Grosso has 21 catches, while Craig Patterson and Tyson Droessler each have 19 and Dan Schwartz 18. Patterson has scored three touchdowns, including the Pioneers' lone score last week in Menomonie with 3:14 in the second quarter.

The Pioneers have now scored in the waning minutes of the first half in all four games. In fact, they have scored 38 of their 54 points in the final 4:07 of the second quarters.

Defensively, the 12 first downs allowed against UW-Stout were the fewest since holding Dubuque to 11 in the 2005 season opener. Linebacker Matt Eastlick leads the team with 32 tackles and two fumble recoveries, while David Pietrowiak, Justin Athey and Morgan May each have 24.

Punter Tom Christiansen has earned one WIAC Player of the Week Award, and kicker Tony Smidl is 2-4 field goals and 4-5 PATs.

The Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point has the second-longest winning streak in the nation at eight games, trailing only two-time defending champion Mount Union.

UWSP cruised through its non-conference schedule, beating Webber International, Iowa Wesleyan and Waldorf by a combined 122-20.

Mike Ferron ran for 199 yards to lead UW-Stevens Point to a wild 45-42 victory over UW-River Falls Saturday at Goerke Field. Pointers' quarterback Jake Swank faked a handoff and raced around the left side 25 yards for a go-ahead touchdown with 2:17 left in the game.

UW-Stevens Point is outscoring its opponents 41.8-15.5 per game. Ferron has nine rushing touchdowns, and Brad Kalsow has caught three scoring passes.

The WIAC:

The Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference was voted the best league in the nation, according to D3football.com.

"The reason the conference has always remained the nation's best is because even its bad teams tend to be hard for teams from other conferences to beat," an article posted Sept. 26 said. "No one schedules a more rugged group of opponents - 10 of the non-conference games have come against Division I FCS, Division II and NAIA opponents."

UWP Homecoming History

UW-Platteville has been playing a Homecoming game every year since 1924, when the Pioneers faced Oshkosh.

The Platteville Normal School did not actually register a Homecoming victory until 1936, when Coach Butch Leitl's team beat Whitewater 13-0. Whitewater was the Homecoming opponent for three straight years, as the Pioneers compiled a 2-0-1 record against their rivals.

Stevens Point's first visit as the Homecoming opponent came in 1946, when the Pioneers registered a 7-0 victory.

One of the most important Homecoming wins came 50 years ago, in 1957, as Platteville beat Oshkosh 25-7 behind two touchdowns by Jack Rickers and a 28-yard pass from Merlyn Blonde to Don Swalter. The victory helped propel the Pioneers to the Wisconsin State College Conference championship in Coach Leitl's 30th season. The Titans also provided the opposition when the Pioneers captured league championships in 1952, 1956, and 1957.

Platteville won four straight league titles from 1968 through 1971, winning the Homecoming game every season. The Pioneers beat Eau Claire 27-7, Stout 44-9, Eau Claire 49-9 and Superior 10-0 in succession to help claim the championships. Those four wins were part of a school-record 11 straight Homecoming victories, which stretched from 1966 until 1977.

UWP won seven straight Homecoming battles from 1988 until 1994, then lost four straight.

In 1999, the Pioneers reversed the four-game streak under first-year coach Mike Emendorfer. UWP overcame a 14-0 deficit to stun conference heavyweight UW-La Crosse 27-14. It was Emendorfer's first WIAC victory and also snapped a 24-game conference losing streak for UW-Platteville. Senior Joel Beard, in his first year of football after playing basketball for four years, threw touchdown passes to Troy Gagner and Reggie Davis, while scoring on a nine-yard fake reverse. The win sent shocks throughout the WIAC and remains one of the most memorable Homecoming moments.
