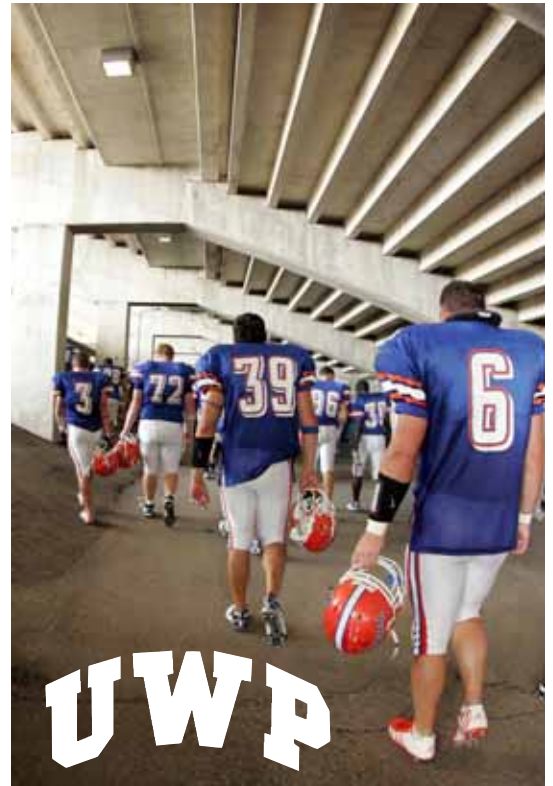

Pioneer Football Media Information

Press Box Facilities

The press box at Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium is one of the finest in all of NCAA Division III. Along with private booths for university officials and other special guests, there are separate booths for the sports information office, three radio stations, coaches from each team, game personnel and the working media. Approximately 70 people can work comfortably in the press box facility. Restrooms are available in the press box.

Working Credentials

Members of the media wishing to cover Pioneer football should notify the sports information office at least two days in advance of the game. Credentials may be picked up at the ticket booth located at the main entrance to the stadium on Southwest Road. Media guides, game programs, game notes, statistics, and probable line-ups will be available in the press box prior to the game.

Statistics - TASLive in Pressbox

Computer monitors carry live statistics in each booth, using the StatCrew TASLive service. These are the same statistics as the official game statistics being generated by the sports information office. You may bring your own laptop or one will normally be provided. Quarterly summaries, halftime statistics, and a full postgame summary will be distributed in a timely fashion. Final statistics include play-by-play.

Radio

Radio stations wishing to broadcast from Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium should contact the sports information office no later than one week prior to the game. A booth in the Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium press box is reserved for the visiting team's radio station. If the radio station is not a member of the WIAC's coupler network, it may be necessary to install a phone line at the stadium, and working space may be limited to a covered roof top facility. Please contact the sports information office as soon as possible for more information.

Photographers

Sideline photographers should notify the sports information office of their intention to cover a Pioneer football game at least two days in advance. Sideline credentials may be picked up at the ticket booth located at the main entrance to the stadium on Southwest Road and must be visible at all times during the game. Photographers may work from the 25-yard-line through the end zone. A sideline pass permits access to the press box.



Telephones/Wireless Access

If a phone line is needed to transmit stories, please notify the sports information office as soon as possible. At least one line will be available in the press box approximately 10 minutes after the game. Additional lines may be available in the press box or in the athletic offices at Williams Fieldhouse. The pressbox now is completely wireless accessible, and a one-day password will be provided to get on the UW-Platteville network.

Parking

Parking can be limited at Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium. Parking passes will accompany media credentials if parking will be available at the stadium on game day. Additional parking is available on Southwest Road outside of the stadium and in on-campus lots one block from the stadium.

Personal Interviews

Interviews with Head Coach Mike Emendorfer should be set up through the sports information office, or contact can be made directly through the coach. The best time to reach Coach Emendorfer is between 10:00 a.m.-noon weekdays at 608.348-1801. All player feature interviews should be set up through the sports information office at least one day in advance. After the game, reporters are welcome on the field to talk with players and coaches once the team meetings end.

What to Watch for in 2008



*UW-Platteville was 2-8 overall in 2007, but held leads in seven of the 10 contests.



*UWP has ranked in the top 14 in passing yards nationally in five of Coach Mike Emendorfer's nine years, including a national-leading 358.8 in 2001. Last year's 1,645 rushing yards were easily the most in his tenure, and the Pioneers ranked 103rd nationally in passing yardage with 1,991 yards.



*The Pioneers scored 30 or more points in four straight games in 2007, the longest such streak since 1969.



*The Pioneers have won their past nine season-opening games.



*UWP returns two all-conference players from 2007, first team defensive lineman David Akey and second team running back Mike Genslinger.



*Akey was the first Pioneer defender since safety Brian Childs and linebacker Tim Duffy in 1999 to garner first team defensive honors. He blocked four kicks and recovered two fumbles. In three seasons, Akey has 127 tackles, including 15 behind the line of scrimmage.



*Genslinger gained 979 rushing yards in nine games last year, missing one due to injury. A 1,028-yard rusher in 2006, Genslinger is trying to become the first player in Pioneer history to record two 1,000-yard seasons. His 4.9 yards per career carry is the second-best mark in Pioneer history.



*Genslinger (149), quarterback Joe Burkeland (151) and Tyson Droessler (114 receiving yards) gave UW-Platteville two 100-yard rushers and a 100-yard receiver in the same game for the first time in school history when the trio accomplished the feat in a 37-34 victory over UW-La Crosse.



*Burkeland, against UW-La Crosse, was the first Pioneer QB to run for more than 100 yards in a game since John Jacobs gained 114 vs. UW-Stout on Nov. 14, 1998.



*Tony Smidl kicked 10 field goals in 2007, the second-most in Pioneer history.

Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium



For 36 years, Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium has been the home of the UW-Platteville Pioneer football team. The picturesque setting includes room for 10,000 fans, making it the second largest in all of NCAA Division III.

The Pioneers sport a 95-81-1 record in their home stadium, which was renovated in 2005 to include a ProGrass in-fill surface. The renovation further ensures the facility as one of the nicest in all of the country.

The stadium was named after Ralph E. Davis, a major contributor, and was christened on Sept. 9, 1972 with a 38-0 Pioneer win over Iowa Wesleyan College. Since that time, thousands of fans have enjoyed the winning tradition of Pioneer football, which has had only nine losing home seasons.

Over the years, Pioneer Stadium has seen several special moments. A quick walk down memory lane reminds the Pioneer fans of some of the best moments at the stadium: the 1976 league champions, whose 4-0 record marks the only time the Pioneers were undefeated and untied in Pioneer Stadium; the 1980 miracle comeback game from a 33-0 deficit against UW-Eau Claire for a 53-43 win; the "Fog Bowl" against UW-Whitewater in 1990; the exciting 24-21 victory over nationally-ranked Augustana in 1995; the 1999 and 2001 Homecoming wins over UW-La Crosse; the 2002 Homecoming victory over UW-Stout in overtime; and the 21-20 upset victory over NCAA Division I Drake in 2003. In an exciting 2004 home season, the Pioneers beat three top 20 teams by a total of six points.

During the fall, Pioneer Stadium serves as the home field for the Platteville High School football team, as well as the Pioneers, and has also been the site of state high school playoff games. Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium and the surrounding practice facilities served as the summer home of the Chicago Bears training camp for 18 years (1984-2002).

The stadium contains two locker rooms, shower rooms, an athletic training area, equipment room, officials' and coaches' dressing area, a concession stand and restrooms. It is topped off on the west stands by a 90-person press box.

When construction originally scheduled for 1971 stalled because the contractors' bids far exceeded the budget set in 1970, Pioneer Stadium was in danger of not being built. However, in 1970, the Tau Kappa Epsilon Fraternity pledged \$100 in honor of Homecoming queen Debbie Kitner to get the ball rolling again. From then on, donations were collected at football and basketball games, in the student center and through the alumni department.

One alum came through generously. Ralph E. Davis's donation helped complete the \$1.25 million dollar facility. Davis was the director of the Wisconsin Mining School from 1910 to 1920. Referred to as the "godfather of the natural gas industry", Davis was instrumental in introducing natural gas to major U.S. cities—and his donation was instrumental in building Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium.

Head Coach Mike Emendorfer

Yes, we will run the ball. We will run with it after we catch it."

With that quote from his 1999 introductory press conference, UW-Platteville Coach Mike Emendorfer ushered in a new, exciting era of Pioneer football.

In Emendorfer's nine seasons, the Pioneers have broken 39 school records and 10 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference marks while playing a wide-open offense.

Emendorfer's spread offense has featured three games with more than 70 pass attempts, yet also contests that saw the single-game rushing record fall when Mike Genslinger ran for 285 yards against UW-River Falls in 2006.



Emendorfer earned the WIAC Coach of the Year Award for 2004, a season in which the Pioneers achieved their first winning record since 1992. The Pioneers finished 6-4, beating top-20 teams Augustana, UW-Whitewater and UW-Eau

Claire. Emendorfer also took his team out to Pennsylvania, where the Pioneers beat Thiel 40-14. Along the way, the team toured Notre Dame and its stadium as well as the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

The travels have not been limited to the United States, as the Pioneers toured parts of Europe and played games in Germany in both 2003 and 2007.

In 1999, his very first year, the Pioneers snapped a

24-game WIAC losing streak with a stunning 27-14 win over UW-La Crosse. The Pioneers more than lived up to their "Thrill is in the Air" motto, as they passed for 2,651 yards and 20 touchdowns, in stark contrast from their former Wing-T running attack.

UW-Platteville fans embraced their exciting brand of ball as well, with attendance jumping by an average of 904 fans per game from the previous year.

The Pioneers have produced some memorable moments over the years, such as beating WIAC favorite UW-Stout 34-31 in overtime on Homecoming 2002 and topping NCAA Division I Drake 21-20 in 2003 and by 33-23 in 2004. UW-Platteville won two games on the final play in 2004, defeating Augustana 25-23 on a last-second field goal and UW-Eau Claire 20-17, when Emendorfer by-passed a chip shot field goal and went for the win with a successful one-yard touchdown plunge. In 2006, the Pioneers overcame a 20-3 deficit to defeat UW-Stout 31-27 during a nationally televised game by Fox Sports Net. The 2007 season featured a 16-6 win over NAIA power St. Ambrose and a 37-34 last-second win over UW-La Crosse, also televised by FSN Wisconsin.

Emendorfer came to UW-Platteville from Hanover (Ind.) College, where he had been the offensive coordinator for eight years. During that time, Hanover won three conference titles, produced two NCAA III playoff berths and led the nation in passing four times. The Pioneers repeated that success in 2001 by leading all of NCAA III in passing yardage with 358.8 yards per game.

Emendorfer previously served as the offensive coordinator at Quincy University and the passing coordinator at Grinnell College before going to Hanover. He and his wife, Lisa, have two children, son Logan, and daughter Rachel.

Pioneer Assistant Coaches

Ulz Daeuber, the longest-serving assistant on the staff, coaches the wide receivers and coordinates the special teams. Daeuber had three receivers earn all-conference honors in 2006 as well as one be selected to the Aztec Bowl. He came to UWP in 1999 after coaching in his native Germany. He coached the linebackers for the German national team that won the Wilson European Junior Championships. He was defensive coordinator for the adult team, Schwaebisch Hall Unicorns. He was a foreign exchange student in Monrovia (Ind.) High School, where he played offensive guard and defensive end. Daeuber has two master's degrees from University of Heidelberg and another from UW-Platteville. He coordinated the successful Pioneer trips to Germany in 2003 and 2007 that culminated in victories over the Unicorns.

Rob Erickson re-joins the Pioneers in 2008 as the new defensive coordinator. He was a four-year starter at defensive back, captaining the team as a senior in 1999. He led the team in interceptions in each of his last three seasons and was second in tackles in both 1997 and 1999. Erickson went on to coach at Stevens Point High School (2000-02), UW-Platteville (2002-03), UW-Stevens Point (2003-04), Iowa Wesleyan (2005) and Aurora (2005-08). He was the defensive coordinator at the last three stops. In 2007, he guided Aurora to a nationally ranked defensive with nine all-conference performers. The Spartans yielded 17 points and 280 yards per game. In two of his three seasons, Erickson led Aurora to first place in the Illini Badger Football Conference in forced turnovers. He finished his bachelor of science degree in history at UW-Stevens Point and earned his master's at UWSP in general education in 2006.

Jason Wagner also is coming home in 2008. The Lancaster native is the new offensive line coach. The former Lancaster Flying Arrow star went on to start at UW-

Stevens Point, helping the Pointers to an NCAA III playoff berth as a senior in 2001. He then coached at his alma mater until leaving in 2004 for Coe. He joined the Aurora staff in 2005. Wagner served as the offensive line coach at all three places and also served as the strength and conditioning coordinator. A health promotions/wellness major, he earned his bachelor's degree from UW-Stevens Point and his master's of science in sports management from California University of Pennsylvania in 2006.

Ryan Munz earned UW-Platteville's George Chryst Award for leadership in 2006. He was a four-year quarterback for the Pioneers who joined the staff in 2007 as an offensive backs coach. The Highland native earned his bachelor's degree in finance and is pursuing his master's at UW-Platteville.

D.J. Lawrence is in his second year coaching he Pioneer secondary. He joined the UWP program after coaching the 2005 and 2006 seasons at Alsono High School in Tampa, Fla. His coaching stint also includes Southhamton High School in Courtland, Va. and West Middlesex High School, Pa. He is a 2001 graduate of Youngstown State University in Ohio and is pursuing his master's degree at UW-Platteville.

Phil Micech is the answer to a great trivia question, as he scored the first points in Arena Football League history, recording a safety. He was a two-time all-league defensive lineman for the Pioneers, in 1981-82, who went on to play for the Minnesota Vikings. Micech coaches the defensive line at his alma mater.

Doug Bark joins the Pioneers in 2008, after a Wisconsin Hall of Fame high school career. He previously was the head coach at Iowa-Grant and won multiple state championships as a Lancaster assistant. He coached in the 1992 Wisconsin High School all-star game. Bark will coach the Pioneer outside linebackers.
