UW-Platteville vs. St. Ambrose

Sept. 13, 2008, 1 p.m. Davenport, Iowa



The Game:

UW-Platteville (1-0) and St. Ambrose (0-1) play Saturday, Sept. 13 at 1 p.m. at Brady Street Stadium, Davenport, Iowa.

The teams are meeting for the 13th time in a series that began in 1916. UWP holds a 10-2 advantage, including last season's 16-6 win in Platteville. The Pioneers are making their first visit to Davenport since winning 27-10 in 1995.

The Coaches:

Yes, we will run the ball. We will run with it after we catch it."

With that quote from his 1999 introductory press conference, UW-Platteville Coach Mike Emendorfer ushered in a new, exciting era of Pioneer football. In Emendorfer's nine seasons, the Pioneers have broken 39 school records and 10 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference marks while playing a wide-open offense. Emendorfer's spread offense has featured three games with more than 70 pass attempts, yet also contests that saw the single-game rushing record fall when Mike Genslinger ran for 285 yards against UW-River Falls in 2006. His 2001 Pioneer squad led all of NCAA III in passing yards, averaging 358.8 yards per game. Emendorfer earned the WIAC Coach of the Year Award for 2004, a season in which the Pioneers achieved their first winning record since 1992. The Pioneers finished 6-4, beating top-20 teams Augustana, UW-Whitewater and UW-Eau Claire. The Pioneers are 31-59 under Emendorfer, a 1986 William Penn graduate.

Mike Magistrelli took the reigns of the St. Ambrose Fighting Bees football program in 2007 and won the Mid-States Football Association Midwest League championship in his first year. The Bees were 8-3 overall and 7-0 in MSFA Midwest League play. The season ended with a 33-27 loss to Saint Xavier in the NAIA playoffs. St. Ambrose led the MSFA in scoring defense (allowing only 12.8 points per game) and pass defense (allowing only 134.7 passing yards per game). The team was second in the conference in total defense, surrendering just over 288 yards per contest. Magistrelli was a two-time all-conference quarterback at Coe College. (Courtesy SAU web site.)

Coach Emendorfer Quotes:

ON THE SEASON OPENER

"We're obviously happy walking out of the game and traveling home being 1-0. The first game of the season is normally a little sloppy at all levels, whether it be the NFL or college. Overall, we were pleased playing a very good football team and a very well-coached team in BV. We were also happy with having the opportunity to be in a close game and win that, which we struggled with last year. That helps us in the future because we will have games like that, and this will help us understand how to face adversity and overcome setbacks."

ON THE PLAY OF AUNTON TERRY

"Aunton Terry is really stepping up. Here's a young man who had only three catches for us last year, and obviously he's by-passed that already with 11 in one game. We hope to see more big games like that out of Aunton. He's athletic, strong, great hands; everything you want out of a receiver."

ON THE IMPORTANCE OF LAST SATURDAY'S VICTORY

"When we look at the non-conference, it's kind of like the NFL preseason. We're preparing ourselves (for the WIAC), but there's something to be said for the mental state. As we gain confidence, we hope to be able to take that momentum into conference play."

ON THE FIGHTING BEES

"St. Ambrose is a team with a lot of new faces. They're NAIA, which means they give out scholarships. They typically have very good athletes. They have a Division I quarterback transfer to them (former Ole Miss QB Will Ducey), and he's 6-6. We'll be playing down at their place, and I'm sure they'll be bitter over last year, losing to us. They were 8-2 and won their conference. I'm sure they'll be very excited. They had a bye week, so they've had an extra week to prepare. They had a lopsided loss at South Dakota, but one I think they anticipated. When you play a team at a Division I level, most coaches go in wanting to compete, and I'm sure they were hoping for an upset, but the biggest thing is staying away from injuries. I think one of their receivers got hurt, but for the most part they came through pretty healthy, judging from their two-deep. They have a lot of new faces on that two deep, and we really don't know that much about them, whether they are transfers or what."

Pioneer Game-Day Preview

Trivial Pursuit, Part 1:

Last Saturday's game was the first time the Pioneers scored 21 points in the fourth quarter since getting 21 in a 41-35 loss at UW-Eau Claire in 2003. The last time the Pioneers had 21 or more fourth-quarter points in a winning effort was scoring 29 in a 46-25 win over Minnesota-Morris on Nov. 14, 1999. The Pioneers have scored 21 points or more in the fourth quarter three times (the other being in a 2002 42-36 overtime setback to UW-Stevens Point) under Coach Mike Emendorfer, and all three have come away from Platteville.

Trivial Pursuit, Part 2:

The Pioneers' comeback from a 14-point deficit at Buena Vista was the largest since overcoming a 20-3 UW-Stout lead to win 31-27 on Sept. 30, 2006.

The Pioneers Last Week:

Aunton Terry caught three fourth-quarter touchdown passes from John Akim, rallying UW-Platteville to a 21-14 victory over Buena Vista Saturday in Storm Lake, Iowa.

Akim and Terry hooked up for a 70-yard scoring pass with 1:48 remaining for the winning score. On a third-and-eight play, Terry caught the ball just past the first down marker, broke a tackle and raced to the end zone.

The Beavers drove down to the 10 in the final seconds, but Courtney Alexander and Quincy Hudson brought down receiver Trent Svendsen one yard shy of the end zone on a fourth-and-goal play from the 10, giving the Pioneers their 10th straight season-opening victory.

Akim threw for 196 of his 308 yards in the fourth quarter alone, including passes to Terry for a 19-yard score with 12:52 remaining and a 25-yarder with 3:35 remaining.

With 213 yards on 11 catches, Terry became the first Pioneer since Matt Kent (288 yards) against UW-Whitewater in 2002 to surpass 200 yards on a game. Akim's 300-yard game was the Pioneers' first since the 2006 campaign.

The Beavers, 5-5 a year ago, led 7-0 at the half on Eric Bertelsen's 51-yard touchdown reception from Matt Pearey. BVU extended the lead to 14-0 early in the third quarter on a Pearey-to-Svendsen connection from 19 yards.

Coach Mike Emendorfer's squad piled up 458 yards of offense, including 344 through the air. Pearey threw for 298 yards of the Beavers' 400 yards.

The Bees Last Game:

The University of South Dakota rolled for 547 yards of total offense in shutting out St. Ambrose 52-0 in the season opener for both teams in the DakotaDome on Saturday, Aug. 30. The Coyotes finished with 299 rushing yards and threw for 248 yards in their first game as an NCAA Division I FCS member.

USD took little time in taking control, scoring on the first possession of the game to grab a 7-0 lead. The Bees stayed close throughout the majority of the first quarter. The Coyotes pushed

across a second touchdown late in the frame for a 14-0 edge. It was the first of four consecutive South Dakota possessions resulting in a touchdown as the lead grew to 35-0 at the half.

St. Ambrose finished with 174 yards of total offense. Brennan McCarron finished with 64 rushing yards on 15 carries. Kyle Ryon added 37 yards on eight rushes. Will Ducey completed 12-of-28 passes for 66 yards. Michael Hayward and Kyle Korth each caught four balls.

Tyler Boyle led the Fighting Bees defense with 10 total tackles, including three tackles-for-loss. Zack Hughes finished with nine tackles and Colin Green had eight stops.

Last Year's Game:

UW-Platteville won its season opener for the ninth straight year and in the process snapped St. Ambrose's 11-game regular-season winning streak with a 16-6 victory at Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium Sept. 8, 2007.

Mike Genslinger scored touchdowns on runs of 3 and 2 yards, and Tony Smidl kicked a 32-yard field goal, all in the second quarter. The Fighting Bees took a 6-0 lead in the first period on Michael Hayward's 5-yard scoring reception from Jim DuPage.

The UWP defense held the visitors from Davenport, Iowa to 229 yards, including 147 over the final three quarters. Justin Athey led the defensive surge with 10 tackles, including three for losses. Eric Jensen and DeMarcus Mitchell each made interceptions on long bombs by DuPage.

Genslinger finished with 156 yards rushing, while Michael Schmidt completed 19 of 30 passes for 191 yards. Craig Patterson caught 5 passes for 110 yards, setting up Genslinger's second score with a 42-yard reception to the one-yard line.

Terry earns WIAC honors:

He grabbed everything thrown his way Saturday, so it was only natural that UW-Platteville's Aunton Terry grabbed the first Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference offensive player of the week award.

Terry, a junior from Waukesha North, caught three fourth-quarter touchdown passes, rallying UW-Platteville to a 21-14 victory over Buena Vista University (Iowa) Sept. 6 in Storm Lake, Iowa. He caught a 70-yard scoring pass with 1:48 remaining for what proved to be the winning score. On a third-and-eight play, Terry caught the ball just past the first down marker, broke a tackle and raced to the end zone. He also caught scoring passes of 19 yards with 12:52 remaining and 25 yards with 3:55 remaining. With 213 yards on 11 catches, Terry became the first Pioneer receiver since Matt Kent (288 yards) against UW-Whitewater in 2002 to surpass 200 yards in a game.
