UW-Platteville vs. Augustana Sept. 27, 2008, 6 p.m. Pioneer Stadium



The Game:

UW-Platteville makes its 2008 Ralph E. Davis Pioneer Stadium debut, playing host to Augustana, Ill. Saturday, Sept. 27 at 6 p.m.

The Pioneers of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) are 1-1 on the year after playing a pair of Iowa schools, beating Buena Vista 21-14 and losing to St. Ambrose 34-17.

The Vikings of the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin (CCIW) are 2-0, beating Coe 21-6 and Greenville, Ill. 30-0.

The Vikings lead the all-time series 8-3, with the 2002 matchup canceled by lightning in the third quarter. Augustana won last year's meeting, 34-24, in Rock Island, while the Pioneers captured the 2006 game in Platteville, 24-7.

The Coaches:

Yes, we will run the ball. We will run with it after we catch it."

With that quote from his 1999 introductory press conference, UW-Platteville Coach Mike Emendorfer ushered in a new, exciting era of Pioneer football. In Emendorfer's nine seasons, the Pioneers have broken 39 school records and 10 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference marks while playing a wide-open offense. Emendorfer's spread offense has featured three games with more than 70 pass attempts, yet also contests that saw the single-game rushing record fall when Mike Genslinger ran for 285 yards against UW-River Falls in 2006. His 2001 Pioneer squad led all of NCAA III in passing yards, averaging 358.8 yards per game. Emendorfer earned the WIAC Coach of the Year Award for 2004, a season in which the Pioneers achieved their first winning record since 1992. The Pioneers finished 6-4, beating top-20 teams Augustana, UW-Whitewater and UW-Eau Claire. The Pioneers are 31-60 under Emendorfer, a 1986 William Penn graduate.

Augustana's Jim Barnes is one win away from a milestone. In his 14th year as a head coach, including nine at Augustana, Barnes, who has a 99-36 career mark, won CCIW titles in 2001, 2005, 2006.

Coach Emendorfer Quotes:

ON WHAT THE PIONEERS DID DURING THE BYE WEEK

"We took it as timeto get back to the fundamentals, and I know most coaches use that cliché, but we didn't really focus on Augustana; we focused on ourselves. We went to morning workouts, early in the morning, and did some walkthroughs. We did a lot of scrimmaging, ones against ones, and we had one of our best practices of the year. We also spent time with each player individually to talk about their goals and their role on the team. Our mind-set is very positive. We have a 24-hour rule to forget about the St. Ambrose loss. We're getting ready for another battle. The non-conference games are the battles, and the war starts with conference play. We want to prepare ourselves as best we can for conference play, and Augustana will be a great test to prepare us for that."

ON WHAT WAS LEARNED DURING THE BYE WEEK

"I learned that we have a great senior class, number one. They provided great leadership. I challenged them this week to bounce back. We had a very tough week of practice, mentally and physically. It was like an August camp. It was a lot of conditioning with a lot of hitting. I think the thing I learned most is the senior leadership group really stepped up."

ON AUGUSTANA

"If you look at the last couple games with them, it's been see-saw, back and forth. Augustana is known as a very physical team in everything they do. I believe the team that wins this game is the team that is more physical and out-hits the other. We have to establish that early on, offensively, defensively and on special teams. Augustana has changed up their offense, but it's the same concept. They're going to run the football. They have a quarterback who is very dangerous with his running ability. Augustana hurt us last year by throwing the football as we committed to stopping the run. They have a new defensive coordinator who will show us some different wrinkles. Their schemes have changed from year's past, but their philosophy is still the same."

ON PLAYING AT HOME

"The coaches and players alike are excited about being in the

environment we create at Pioneer Stadium. It's one of the most unique environments at Division III football, especially under the lights and with the band and everything. Our players are looking forward to playing at home in front of the student body. We keep telling everyone this is the 2008 team. We don't want to be defined by anything else, but the way we play on Saturdays this fall. We can't wait to play."

The Pioneers:

UW-Platteville is looking to put together two good halves Saturday after showing plenty of promise in the first two games. John Akim and Aunton Terry hooked up for three fourth-quarter touchdown passes to rally UWP past Buena Vista 21-14 Sept. 6. Terry earned WIAC Player of the Week honors after catching 11 passes for 213 yards, the first Pioneer to surpass 200 receiving yards in a game since Matt Kent in 2002.

The Pioneers built a 17-7 lead at St. Ambrose Sept. 13, but the Bees, ranked 10th in the NAIA poll, stormed back to win 34-17. Nick Grosso caught a scoring pass and blocked a punt, which Jon Martin returned 32 yards for a touchdown.

All-conference defensive lineman David Akey leads the defense with 10 solo stops, including two sacks, while linebacker Joe Tinucci has 17 total tackles.

The Vikings:

Augustana implemented a spread offense in 2008 after decades of running the wishbone and found the perfect quarterback to orchestrate the change. Tim Podulka, at 5-7, has used his quickness to rush for 110 yards, averaging 5.8 yards per carry, and throw for 175 more. Jake Parke is the leading receiver and has also scored four times on the ground.

The Vikings rolled up 289 rushing yards and 160 passing in beating Greenville 30-0 Sept. 13. The Vikings scored on their first four possessions of the second half. The defense forced three fumbles and two interceptions while allowing just 195 yards. Eric Meyer led the team in tackles for the second straight week.

Last Year's Game:

Augustana scored the final 17 points of the game and beat UW-Platteville 34-24 Sept. 22 in Rock Island, Ill.

The 29th-ranked Vikings overcame the Pioneers' 24-17 lead with touchdown runs of one yard by Josh Galliard (2:21 left in the third quarter) and of 26 by Jake Parke (4:23 left in the fourth), both ending 72-yard drives. They sandwiched a Ryan Gibbons 47-yard field goal, which came with 9:19 remaining in the contest.

UWP's Craig Patterson caught two touchdown passes from Michael Schmidt. The first was a 26-yard score that gave the Pioneers a 17-10 lead 17 seconds before halftime, and the second a 28-yard hookup with 6:37 remaining in the third quarter for the 24-17 lead. The Vikings then gained 201 yards and scored 17 points on their next three drives.

Augustana improved to 2-1, while the Pioneers fell to 1-2.

Mike Genslinger scored a 15-yard touchdown run and Tony Smidl kicked a 19-yard field goal in the first half for the Pioneers. Genslinger rushed for 96 yards on 21 carries, just missing his third straight 100-yard game. Schmidt completed 28 of 41 passes for 210 yards, including 11 for 73 yards to Grosso and 9 for 54 yards to Dan Schwartz. Grosso also completed a two-point conversion pass to Patterson right before halftime.

Jason Doestch carried the ball 16 times for 84 yards for Augustana, while quarterback Ryan McGinnis ran for 62 yards and passed for 138, including a 38-yard touchdown to Henry Peters four minutes into the game. Parke finished with a pair of rushing touchdowns.

The Pioneers' Matt Eastlick led all tacklers with 13, including 12 solo stops. David Pietrowiak and Morgan May each made 8 solo tackles. Dan Hilby had a pair of quarterback sacks for Augustana.
