Demands of the Work Force

- College Hiring Up 13.8%

Employers responding to NACE's Job Outlook 2006 Spring Update survey confirmed the positive hiring projections they made for 2005-06 college graduates in August 2005. Respondents reported they expected to increase their college hiring by 13.8%.

Hiring Projections by Region: Midwestern employers expected to increase college hires by 9.8%. In other areas: Northeast employers projected a 24.8% increase; Southern employers projected a 13.8% increase; and employers in the West reported a 5.8% planned increase.

Internship Experience: From the class of 2005, employers report that 62.5% of their college hires came to them with internship experience and just over one-quarter (26%) had co-op experience. More than three-quarters of respondents (75.9 percent) said the primary focus of their internship program is to feed their college recruiting program. Overall, employers reported plans to increase their intern hires in 2005-06 by 9.8%. On average, respondents converted 53% of their interns (from the class of 2005) to full-time hires.



Student teachers can network with school principals and administrators that participate annually in the education drive-in seminars; discussion focuses on interview preparation, resume/cover letter do's and don'ts, and educational employment opportunities.

Co-op It Works: Employers in the Midwest were most likely to identify recruiting as their co-op program's purpose (92.6%).
