Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a system of weekly delivery or pick-up of a box of seasonal produce, sometimes dairy products and meat. Consumers purchase a membership.

Organic means a commitment to an agriculture that strives for a balance with nature, using farming methods and materials which have a low impact on the environment.

Sustainable agriculture describes systems for producing adequate yields and good profits using practices that minimize negative short-and long-term side effects on the environment.
