University of Wisconsin-Platteville & Iowa Central Community College

This agreement facilitates an additional transfer of credits from the Criminal Justice Degree Program at Iowa Central Community College to the Criminal Justice Bachelor of Science Degree program at UW Platteville.

Per policy, at least 18 of the required credits in the major must be completed under the direction of UW Platteville

OTHER:

1. In order for these courses to transfer, the student must have completed the courses within the last 15 academic years of when a student is admitted to UWP and earned a grade of "C" or better.
2. The maximum number of credits that can be transferred into UW Platteville to count toward the Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice degree is 72 credits, of which up to 30 are applicable to the general education requirements.
3. The UWP baccalaureate degree candidate must meet all the general education requirements of the University.
