

Transfer Agreement
The University of California at Davis Extension and
The University of Wisconsin-Platteville
Master of Science in Project Management

Completion of the UC-Davis Extension Certificate in Project Management program (whether delivered online, classroom or combination) equates to 12 graduate credits in the UW-Platteville Master of Science in Project Management program, under the following stipulations:

- 1) The University of California-Davis Extension Certificate in Project Management program **must be completed prior** to being admitted to the M.S. in Project Management program at UW-Platteville.
- 2) A grade of "B" or better must be earned in each course of the UC-Davis Extension certificate program to be eligible for transfer into the UW-Platteville M.S. in Project Management program.
- 3) UC-Davis students are excluded from taking BSAD 5540 Quality Management at UW-Platteville due to content similarities with X455.10 below.
- 4) UC - Davis Extension recommends taking the courses in the following sequence:

- 5) Completion of the UC-Davis Extension Certificate in Project Management (22 quarter credits) equates to 12 graduate transfer credits when granted admission into the UW-Platteville M.S. in Project Management program, in the following manner:
