

Transfer Agreement
The University of California at Berkeley Extension and
The University of Wisconsin-Platteville
Master of Science in Project Management

Completion of the UC-Berkeley Extension Certificate in Project Management program (whether delivery via online, classroom or combination) equates to 12 graduate credits in the UW-Platteville Master of Science in Project Management program, under the following stipulations:

- 1) The University of California-Berkeley Extension Certificate in Project Management program ***must be completed prior*** to being admitted to the M.S. in Project Management program at UW-Platteville.
- 2) A grade of “B” or better must be earned in each course of the UC-Berkeley, Extension certificate program to be eligible for transfer into the UW-Platteville M.S. in Project Management program.
- 3) UC Berkeley Extension recommends taking the courses in the following sequence:

a. X470 Project Management	2 credits
b. X407.7 Contract Management	2 credits
c. X470.9 Quality Management	2 credits
d. X469.2 Human Factors and Team Dynamics for Project Management	3 credits
e. X440.4 Project Risk Management	2 credits
f. X471.9 Project Planning and Control	3 credits
TOTAL	14 credits

- 4) Completion of the UC-Berkeley Extension Certificate in Project Management (14 semester credits) equates to 12 graduate transfer credits when granted admission into the UW-Platteville M.S. in Project Management program, in the following manner:

a. PM 7010 Project Management Techniques I	3 credits
b. PM 7020 Project Management Techniques II	3 credits
c. Project Management Electives	6 credits
