

2008 Summer School Instructions

READ CAREFULLY

- In order to be considered for financial aid during summer 2008, you must have been enrolled as a degree seeking student in the spring of 2008 at UW-Platteville. (Exception is first time graduate students admitted for summer.)
- Undergraduate students must be enrolled in summer school for at least 6 credits and graduate students must be enrolled for at least 5 credits.
- You must have a 2007-2008 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form on file.

“Special” students and students attending UW-P for summer school only are not eligible for financial aid.

Students dismissed from UWP at the end of the spring semester are not eligible for summer financial aid and any offer of aid will be cancelled. Students not maintaining academic progress at the end of the spring semester are not eligible for financial aid and any offer of aid will be cancelled.

Summer Financial Aid Available

Subsidized/Unsubsidized Stafford Loan – Federal regulations limit a student’s borrowing to specific time periods. UW-P time period is fall, spring and summer. If you borrowed your Stafford Loan maximum during the 2007-08 academic year you will not be eligible for additional loan for summer. An exception to this is if you advance a grade level and your new level has a higher academic year maximum.

Federal Pell Grant – May be available if a student did not receive full Pell Grant eligibility during the academic year.
