

New Freshman Scholarships 2008-2009

GENERAL UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

AMERICAN BANK & TRUST--WISCONSIN COMMUNITY

Criteria: Awarded to new freshman from the following high schools: Cuba City, Hazel Green, Lancaster, Fennimore and Platteville. Must be in top half of graduating class and demonstrate financial need. Must have a 2.75 GPA or better during first semester and will be awarded during second semester of freshman year.

JAMES AZIM

Criteria: Graduate of any Grant County high school. Academic achievement and community involvement.

VANDY "BUTCH" BLOYER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: must be a student from River Ridge High School, WI.

LEO E. BOEBEL MEMORIAL

Criteria: High school graduate of Crawford, Grant, Iowa, Lafayette, Richland, or Vernon Counties. May continue for 4 academic years.

CERES

Criteria: Any freshman female who has an appreciation for agriculture and displays outstanding leadership, excellence in academics and extra-curricular activities. Agriculture major not required, however, some preference may be given to an agriculture major or person with rural background.

RITA AND RALPH CURTIS SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be graduate of Cuba City High School in Cuba City, WI. Preference given to students with GPA of 3.0 or higher, involved in extra-curricular activities and exhibits financial need.

THAROLD DORN

Criteria: Recipient shall show scholastic achievement, participants in extracurricular activities and demonstrate character.

FARMHOUSE

Criteria: Any major, freshman who displays outstanding leadership, excels in academics and extra-curricular activities and has an appreciation for agriculture. Agriculture major not required, but must join FarmHouse Fraternity

FRENCH SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be a Sheboygan County high school student. Must have demonstrated leadership and have at least a 2.75 GPA. Priority given to those who show financial need.

JERRY GUNDERSON SCHOLARSHIP FOR APPLETON WEST HIGH SCHOOL

Criteria: Eligible for any Appleton West High School graduate. Preference given to students pursuing a degree in the following majors: Biology Reclamation, Environment and Conservation, Soil & Crop Science, Chemistry, Mathematics or Fine Arts.

JOYCE E. IRISH VETERANS SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be a U.S. Veteran or a child of a U.S. Veteran. Must have an ACT score of 18 or higher and needs to be in satisfactory standing.

JORDAN C. AND DIDO NASH

Criteria: Majoring in education, engineering, agriculture or chemistry. Students must be a resident of Sauk, Vernon, Juneau, Richland or Marathon County.

PRUDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Student must be from the Tri-State area with a minimum GPA of 3.2. Must be pursuing a major in Business and Accounting.

SENTRY INSURANCE FOUNDATION LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Top 15 percent; GPA 3.3; pursue degree in business administration, computer science, accounting, finance, mathematics (actuarial science) or engineering; high school leadership.

FLOY KIES SMYTHE

Criteria: Recipient must have an overall GPA of 3.0, participation in extracurricular activities and/or provide leadership experience.

TABER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Incoming UWP student, resident of Grant County Wisconsin or a county contiguous to Grant County. Preference to military veterans (National Guard or the reserve). Need is not a factor.

UWP LICENSE PLATE

Criteria: Current Wisconsin resident (based on UWP residency requirements for tuition); must show participation in co-curricular activities, outstanding leadership ability, strong character, campus involvement and academic achievement.

ZETA BETA CHI CHAPTER

Criteria: Must be incoming freshman who demonstrates outstanding leadership qualities and has community involvement. Student must maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher and agree to attend at least one rush event and introduce herself to the group. Scholarship will applied to Spring semester tuition bill.

COLLEGE OF BUSINESS, INDUSTRY, LIFE SCIENCE AND AGRICULTURE

AG/BIOLOGY ALUMNI-BIOLOGY

Criteria: Students majoring in Biology may apply.

RAY A. BOURKNEY

Criteria: Recipient shall be enrolled as an incoming student to UWP who has declared a major administrated by the College of BILSA.

BUILDING CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Criteria: Must be enrolled/listed as ITM/ Building Construction Management major.

BUSINESS AND ACCOUNTING

Criteria: Major in Business and Accounting; top 15 percent of graduating senior class; resident of Grant, Iowa, or Lafayette County; renewable for four years if 3.0 GPA is maintained.

JAMES R. AND MARY L. COOLEY

Criteria: Graduate of River Ridge High School. May declare any major within College of BILSA. Preference given to students with declared majors in School of Agriculture.

PERCY LAVON JULIEN SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be a member of an under-represented minority population, enrolling in Biology and/or Chemistry program. Must have a letter of reference from High School teacher.

QUEEN B RADIO SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must declare a major in Communication Technologies and must graduate from the Platteville High School.

TRICOR, INC.

Criteria: Must declare a major in Business or accounting. Must have graduated from high school located in Grant, Iowa, Lafayette County in Wisconsin or from Dubuque County in Iowa.

RUTH HARMAN WALRAVEN WOMEN IN INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY

Criteria: Majoring in Industrial Technology Management or Technology Education.

SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURE

AG/BIOLOGY ALUMNI-AGRICULTURE

Criteria: Students majoring in Agriculture may apply.

AGRIBUSINESS/AGRICULTURE ECONOMICS ALUMNI

Criteria: High school record; must be agriculture business/agriculture economics major.

AGRICULTURE ALUMNI CHAPTER

Criteria: Agriculture major may apply. Committee will look at high school record and activities.

ALPHA GAMMA RHO

Criteria: Must be majoring in agriculture, high school FFA member and eligible to become AGR member.

ATTEN AND BABLER AGRICULTURE

Criteria: Must be from the Illinois counties of Jo Davies, Stephenson or Winnebago enrolled in any agriculture major. Preference given to students who have demonstrated involvement in a FFA organization or have an agriculture background.

FIRST BANKING CENTER AGRICULTURE LENDERS COMMUNITY

Criteria: Incoming freshman seeking a degree in any agriculture field from the school districts in the following counties: Grant, Lafayette and Green counties in Wisconsin. Financial need will be a consideration in the selection.

CURT AND LINDA HANSON

Criteria: New student in the School of Agriculture as a major. Selection will be based on scholastic achievement, involvement in agriculture organizations and need.

JOHN HASKINS SCHOLARSHIP IN ANIMAL SCIENCE

Criteria: Must major in animal science.

MID-STATE EQUIPMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be pursuing a degree in Ag Engineering Technology or in Agribusiness, preference given to child of current employee of Mid-State Equipment and preference given to student from Wisconsin.

SOIL AND CROP SCIENCE (Agronomy)

Criteria: Major in Soil and Crop Science; based on academic achievement.

WISCONSIN FARM CREDIT SERVICES

Criteria: Must be an agriculture major.

WISCONSIN LIVESTOCK & MEAT COUNCIL

Criteria: Upper 50 percent of class; animal science major; Wisconsin resident.

WISCONSIN RURAL OPPORTUNITIES SCHOLARSHIP/LOAN

Criteria: School of Agriculture, WI farm resident; financial need (Recipients must complete a FAFSA no later than July 1). The recipient will receive \$1000 scholarship and \$1000 loan for the academic year.

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE

ROY AND GLORIA BERNARD SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be a graduate from Tomahawk High School majoring in engineering. Must show financial need.

GEORGE BULLIS

Criteria: Mathematics major or pursuing a career requiring high math aptitude (e.g. mathematics, physics, or engineering, etc.); preferably a National Merit Scholarship Finalist; possibility to extend for entire undergraduate program.

CHEMISTRY FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Chemistry Major; top 10 percent of graduating Senior class; ACT score of 25 or greater; \$250.00 for first semester, renewable for second semester if GPA of 3.00 is maintained.

CLARKE DIETZ, INC.

Criteria: Must declare a major in engineering- preferably civil and environmental engineering.

TAY AND ANNA (FRANCES) DRESDEN

Criteria: Student must major either in the School of Education or College of Engineering, Mathematics and Science. Students need to be from a rural community background.

JENNIE L. AND ORLYN P. EDGE

Criteria: Must be enrolled as full-time student and in a math course at or above level of calculus, intend to major in mathematics, need is not a factor.

WILLIAM EILER MEMORIAL

Criteria: Any engineering major.

RALPH AND MARGARET HENRY SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must be a freshman majoring in engineering and show financial need. Preference given to student(s) from Mt. Hope, WI or from River Ridge High School, WI.

WILLIAM D. KENT

Criteria: Entry level students (freshman or sophomores) pursuing degrees in engineering; demonstration of financial need (FAFSA required to be on file); academic good standing with a minimum GPA of 2.0 on 4.0 scale.

NORMAN POWERS

Criteria: Platteville High School graduate, majoring in engineering; 4.0 or close to a 4.0.

WILLIAM A. & JEAN C. SANDERS SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Must declare a math major and enroll in a mathematics course at or above the level of calculus. Each recipient must qualify for one of the below items:

- Selected to the All-Academic team at the annual UWP Mathematics Contest.
- Scored among the top two percent of students taking the MAA (Wisconsin) Mathematics Contest Exam.
- Placed in the top 250 students in Wisconsin on the American High School Mathematics Exam (AHSME)
- Received an A or B in a calculus class at UWP while completing high school.
- Received a score of at least 30 on the mathematics component of the ACT. Must have an overall GPA of 3.0.

FREDRIC W. TUFTE SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria: Entering freshman with preference given to sons and daughters of Wisconsin school teachers.

WOMEN IN ENGINEERING, MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE

Criteria: Freshman or Transfer student with an appreciation for (majoring in an area) Engineering, Mathematic and Science. Must display outstanding leadership, excellence in academics and extra-curricular activities. Special deadline of Feb. 29, 2008. Special application required.
