Ullsvik Center Addition and Remodeling
University of Wisconsin–Platteville

The University of Wisconsin–Platteville (UW-PLT) proposes implementation of an exterior development project that impacts the UW-PLT campus in Platteville, Wisconsin. The Ullsvik Center is located at the northeast corner of the campus at the southwest quadrant of the intersection of Hickory Street and Main Street. The Ullsvik Center redevelopment includes an addition to the existing structure and extensive remodeling.

An Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) has been compiled for the proposed development, which is planned for implementation during 2006.
