RATIONALE: The Computer Science major at UW-Platteville offers a Bachelor of Science degree in two emphases: Computer Technology and Computer Information Systems. Computer Science major has many common offerings with the associate degree (Computer Information Systems – Programmer/Analyst) at Southwest Technical College.

A student with an associate degree in Computer Information Systems – Programmer/Analyst from Southwest Technical College will be able to broaden academic interests and skills by taking upper level courses in computer science and related areas such as accounting, business administration, and mathematics.

- This list replaces any previously approved list.
- If the student changes from Computer Science major or transfer to another UW campus, these professional/vocational courses may not necessary transfer.
- Effective Date: This agreement is effective as of November 18, 2003. The agreement covers courses which have been previously approved by the UW-System.

Definition:

Program-to-program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the program/degree specified in this agreement. A change of major/degree/program invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other program-to-program Articulation Agreement for a different major/degree/program at UW-Platteville.
