## **General Criteria for International Study Scholarship**

1. Student must be enrolled full-time in a UWP business or accounting major or minor program in the semester preceding the international experience
2. Student will be participating in a full-semester program.
3. Students will be required to give up to 5 presentations on their experiences to UWP students and faculty.
4. Student must consult with their academic advisor regarding international study. Signature of the academic advisor on the application form is required.
5. International Study Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis. The criteria for awarding the scholarship will be based upon the following:
  - a. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.50
  - b. Statement of Participation
  - c. Meets eligibility requirements (see criteria #1, 2 and 3)
6. Awarding of scholarship monies is dependent on the applicant being accepted by the intended overseas program of study

**Special note: the student will be responsible for repayment of any money awarded if he/she does not complete the international program requirements.**
