

Public Informational Meeting for the University of Wisconsin – Platteville Storm Water Management Plan is Scheduled for Thursday, October 12th.

A public informational meeting about the campus storm water management plan is scheduled from 6 P.M. to 8 P.M on October 12th at the Pioneer Student Center, Platteville Room on the University of Wisconsin Platteville campus. Parking is available in Lots 9 and 26. This meeting will consist of a half-hour formal presentation starting at 6:15 pm followed by a question and answer period. The meeting will discuss the draft storm water management plan completed in August 2006 and will include a slide presentation and exhibits displaying the recommended improvements. The storm water management plan includes maps for existing watershed areas, waterways, banks and shorelines, floodplains, environmental corridors, wetlands, lakes, ponds and detention basins, storm water drainage facilities, drainage problem areas, existing and proposed land use, soils, and recommended improvement and/or repairs. The plan analyzes existing drainage systems, identifies potential impacts of known future development, assesses existing and potential infiltration, models water quality, recommends system improvements, proposes an implementation plan for any and all recommendations, and documents best management practices. Representatives from the campus, University of Wisconsin System, State of Wisconsin Department of Administration/Division of State Facilities, and Strand Associates will be on hand to answer questions and receive comments.
