

STUDY, TEST TAKING TIPS

After you read a passage, restate it out loud in your own words

Pose questions to yourself, your fellow students and your instructor

Give other examples of the concept not noted in the text

Relate concepts to something in your own experience

Record notes onto a cassette tape. You will hear your voice for reinforcement

Draw a picture or diagram of the concept

Use mnemonic devices I.E. ROY G BIV

Find out what environment you study best in

Determine best time of day to study

Remove distractions

Find out how you learn best -use multiple Intelligences

Read test question and *all* answers completely *before* answering

For multi choice read each answer one at a time at the end of question

Rule out answers that don't make sense

Look for words in **bold** or *italics* or words that are underlined

Watch out for the words NOT, ALWAYS, NEVER

Is the statement more true than false?

What is the real question that is being asked? Clarify if you need to.

If you don't have an answer for a question don't spend too much time on it,
mark the question and come back to it

Don't be in a rush to finish. Take your time check your work.

Your first response is generally correct, don't second guess too much
