Per policy, at least 18 of the required credits in the major must be completed under the direction of UW-Platteville

- 1) In order for these courses to transfer, the student must have completed the courses within the last 15 academic years of when a student is admitted to UW-Platteville and earned a grade of "C" or better.
- 2) The maximum number of credits that can be transferred into UW-Platteville to count toward the Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice degree is 72 credits, of which up to 30 are applicable to the general education requirements.
- 3) The UW-Platteville baccalaureate degree candidate must meet all the general education requirements of the University.
