





### WHAT WE CONSIDER

At UW-Platteville Richland, we're looking for determined individuals who want to achieve excellence, create opportunities, and empower themselves, their communities, and the world. While academic potential is a part of what makes a great student, we also consider the personal factors reflected in your essay. The following are some of the items we take into account while reviewing your application:

- GPA and class rank
  - New freshmen are likely to be admitted to UW-Platteville Richland if they rank in the top 75% of their class and successfully complete the minimum college preparatory units.
- Academic courses from ninth through 12th grades. Minimum college preparatory credits required include:
  - English: 4 units
  - Mathematics: 3 units
    - One unit of algebra
    - One unit of geometry
  - Natural science: 3 units
  - Social science: 3 units
  - Electives: 4 units
    - Additional courses from the above areas, foreign language, fine arts, computer science, or other academic areas
- Course rigor
- ACT or SAT scores (not required)

To apply for most financial aid—including grants, loans, and federal work-study—you must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. File online at fafsa.ed.gov as early as Oct. 1, using the UW-Platteville school code 003921.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarship opportunities of varying amounts are offered for new and continuing students.

The deadline to apply for a New Student Scholarship is April 1. Visit **uwplatt.edu/richland/richland-paying-college** for details and to access the scholarship application.

### **RICHLAND PROMISE**

Through the Richland Promise, newly admitted freshmen for the 2021–22 school year that submit a completed scholarship application will receive a minimum of \$500 to support their studies.
